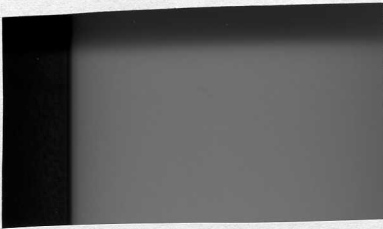

Kevin Allen = Kebin Haller

I want to file a formal complaint against several workers for DCI. I received several threatening phone calls from 2 workers at DCI abusing their authority and trying to step into a civil case. Starting on November 5th in the evening Steve [REDACTED] called my mothers house ([REDACTED]) on several occasions stating that I had to have my children home at a certain time and that I was mentally unstable to be left alone with them. He threatened to call the USAF and have my husband and myself arrested for taking my children out of town. He told my mother other choice threatening things to try to make me do what he wanted. I called DCI in the morning to report at one of their workers was harassing me and that it needed to stop. I received a return phone call from Kevin Allen only to be yelled and threatened to be thrown in jail over a custody issue which they have no jurisdiction over. He stated that he had my neighborhood surrounded and that I was a felon for having my children. He told me that I had 5 mins to call my ex to hand over my children or he was going to cost my LT of a husband his job and I would be in jail. He stated that the AF base was constantly on the phone with him and that they were aware of the situation. I called the LE desk on base and they had no clue what I was talking about and that it wasn't part of their jurisdiction unless we live on base. I called the police only to be told by Kevin Allen that he knew about my call and had stopped the police from coming over to my house when I was scared physically of my ex. Kevin Allen then called back again and I warned him that any other phone calls that he makes to me from now on will be recorded due to the fact that he has been threatening me. Kevin at that point took it upon himself to call me a few choice names and yell even louder at me. I told him that I was aware that this was a civil matter and that he has no jurisdiction over this case and I was tired of his threats. I called a supervisor of the police department also to report that I was being threatened at the time a police officer showed up with my ex. The police officer that came over told me that my entire neighborhood was surrounded by DCI and was going to arrest me when I left the house. The supervisor at the police department told me that he was aware of the situation and that the harassing phone calls would stop. I want to make sure that the DCI officers involved get some type of discipline for abusing their authority and making threats against myself and my family. DCI deals with drugs not civil matters such as a child custody case that was allowed to go on without the other party allowed to be there. I know that what they have done violates my civil rights as a US citizen. Any help that you can provide will be appreciated.
