Sir,

I recently emailed my petition to the state legislature in opposition of a pending concealed weapons bill. At least one House member from Park County violated state Title 6 and sent my email to a criminal in Park County who described me as "dangerous" and said he carries a concealed weapon. I don't think that Park county law enforcement is dealing with this man (who does not have a concealed weapons permit) because it's so common to carry weapons illegally in Wyoming as to be a non-issue.

Last week, someone inside the State Capitol violated Title 6 of Wyoming state law and used state phones to harass me at my house. And nobody at the DCI or state AG office is doing anything to identify this person who (like the Park County House member) is seeking to intimidate me from petitioning my government. After I leave this letter with you I'll be visiting my fraternity brother's law firm in Cheyenne to discuss the state not offering me equal protection under the law.

The culture of law enforcement abuse in Wyoming has reached the level where the Albany County Sheriff is now prosecuting a former deputy for larceny with a deceptively-worded, false complaint; which the local DA agreed to prosecute without even reading it!
